Acorns




Monday, June 10 - Friday, June 14 1:00 PM - 3:30 PM

Saplings




Monday, June 10 - Friday, June 14 1:00 PM - 3:30 PM

Thursday, July 11 - Friday, July 12 9:30 AM - 3:30 PM (2 day camp)



- School distict and student ID # (only required for Eau Claire, Chippewa Falls, Altoona, and Augusta school districts)
- Credit card number, expiration, and CCV code
- Child's doctor's name, address, and phone number
- Child's allergies, medication, dietary needs, or language needs
- If there is a need for a support staff, please indicate that on registration

HOW TO REGISTER

Registration will be through <u>Village.com</u>! We encourage creating an account and adding your camper(s) profile(s) before registration opens. Cancellation Policy: All summer camp cancellations require a **seven business day** notice prior to the date of the camp in order to receive a refund, minus a 10% processing fee. Cancellations made less than three business days prior to the date of the camp are not eligible for a refund.

*If your child/children **can no longer attend** a summer camp that they were registered for, please contact Beaver Creek Reserve as soon as possible so we can **open the spot for a waitlisted camper**.

Eligibility: A camper is eligible for a camp if their incoming grade matches the grade level(s) of the camp. Campers that do not meet the grade requirement are unable to attend that camp.

**Please Note: due to the active nature of the program and limited resources, camps are unable to accommodate persons with serious emotional, physical, mental, or medical limitations.
