- Submit pictures or a video (3 minute limit), and a description of your project that answers the following questions:
 - 1. What is your hypothesis?
 - 2. What is your conclusion?
 - 3. What recycled/reused materials did you use?

To qualify for the At-Home Science Fair, you must follow all the rules listed above. Once you have completed all steps, follow the directions below to submit your project online.
